GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, on March 22, 2023, you submitted a "Second Sheriff's Progress Report", requesting this Labor Arbiter to issue an Order directing the Assistant Vice President of Landbank of the Philippines, to convert into Manager's check the garnished amounts of Php10,840.00 in the name of NLRC RAB X to partially satisfy the judgment award and an updated writ of execution;

WHEREAS, after deducting from the total monetary award the garnished amounts, it shows that there is still a remaining balance of **ONE MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SIX PESOS AND 69/100 (Php1,877,406.69)**;

Hence, this 2nd Updated Writ.

WHEREFORE, by law, you are commanded to collect, in accordance with Section 9, Rule XI of the 2011 NLRC Rules of Procedure, as amended, the amount of **ONE MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SIX PESOS AND 69/100 (Php1,877,406.69)** from respondent Fortunato R. Parantar, as owner/proprietor of **FORTUNE P SECURITY AGENCY**, whose address on record is at: 1321 Lentija Street, Pob. Compostela Valley, 8803 Comval Province (now Davao de Oro) or, anywhere in the Philippines where they may be located, representing complainants' remaining judgment award.

You are also commanded, to collect from the respondent the execution fee in the amount of Php21,594.70 and deposit fee of Php11,547.35 pursuant to the Manual on Execution.

In case you fail to collect the amounts above-mentioned from the respondent, or the amount collected is insufficient to satisfy the judgment award, you are ordered to cause the satisfaction of the judgment award in accordance with the order of enforcement stated in Section 9, (a), Rule XI of the 2011 NLRC Rules of Procedure, as amended, to wit: (a) Bank deposits; (b) Surety Bond, (c) personal property of respondent not exempt from execution; and (d) Real Property of respondent.


If the bonding company refuses to comply with the 2nd updated writ of execution, you may proceed to levy on the personal property, and if insufficient, the real property of the bonding company, without prejudice to contempt proceedings against its officers or authorized representatives.

You are to implement simultaneous service of the 2nd updated writ to respondent and notice of garnishment to the bank by furnishing the losing party with the copy of the writ through registered mail or authorized courier and personally serving the notice of garnishment to the bank.

You are to serve this updated writ within three (3) days from receipt of the same, subject to the requirements of section 12 and 13 Rule XI of the 2011 NLRC Rules of Procedure.

You are to return updated Writ immediately after the full satisfaction of the judgment award. In case of partial or non-satisfaction of the judgment award, you are to submit a report updating the undersigned on the status of the enforcement thereof, not later than thirty (30) days from receipt of such Writ and every thirty (30) days thereafter during the lifetime of the Writ unless fully satisfied. You are to furnish a copy of your report to the Chairman and the Executive Labor Arbiter.
