**WRIT OF EXECUTION**

GREETINGS:

Record shows that on 30 June 2023, a Decision was issued by then Labor Arbiter Benedict G. Kato, the dispositive portion of which reads:

"WHEREFORE, upon the foregoing findings, E & E Royal Couple Bus, Inc. is hereby **ORDERED** to pay complainant's benefits per attached *Computation Sheet* which forms part hereof.

The complaint for constructive dismissal is **DISMISSED** for lack of merit.

**SO ORDERED."**

WHEREAS, on 28 November 2023, a Certificate of Finality was issued by this Office declaring the Decision dated 30 June 2023, final and executory as of 07 August 2023.

WHEREAS, on 28 December 2023, during the pre-execution conference, only complainant appeared. No appearance from the respondents.

WHEREAS, there is no legal impediment to the issuance of a writ of execution there being no temporary restraining order or preliminary injunction.

Hence, this Writ.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, you are hereby commanded to proceed to the premises of respondent **E & E ROYAL COUPLE BUS, INC.** at 47-C Rupee St., Phase 8, North Fairview, Quezon City or wherever it may be found, then and there to collect the judgment award of **Seventy Two Thousand One Hundred Thirty Three Pesos and 98/100 (Php72,133.98)**.

Further, you are commanded to collect from respondent bus company the execution fee in the amount of **Eight Hundred Pesos & 0/100 (Php800.00)** and deposit fee of **Three Hundred Eighty Pesos and 67/100 Pesos (Php380.67)** pursuant to the Manual on Execution of Judgment.

In case you fail to collect from respondent's goods or chattel, or in the absence thereof, from respondent's immovable properties not exempt from execution.

You are commanded, further, to turn-over to the Cashier of this Commission whatever amount you have collected for further disposition in accordance with law.

This Writ of Execution will expire five (5) years from receipt hereof.
