**GREETINGS:**

WHEREAS, on May 31, 2024, the undersigned Labor Arbiter promulgated a Decision, the dispositive portion of which is hereunder quoted as follows:

“WHEREFORE, premises considered, judgment is hereby rendered finding complainants Christopher L. Amurao, Lavern P. Sipin, Nor-Ali B. Dibaratun and Jimmy P. Palaganas, illegally dismissed. Accordingly, respondent MET Express Air Corp. is hereby ORDERED to PAY the complainants the following: a) separation pay with full backwages from the date of their dismissal up to the finality of this decision; b) 13<sup>th</sup> month pay and service incentive leave pay; c) wage differentials of complainant Christopher L. Amurao; and d) attorney's fees equivalent to ten percent (10%) of the total monetary award. All other claims are DISMISSED for lack of basis.

The attached computation prepared by the Labor Arbitration Associate shall form part of this Decision.

SO ORDERED.”

WHEREAS, a Certificate of Finality was issued on July 19, 2024 declaring that the Decision dated May 31, 2024, has become final and executory;

WHEREAS, on July 29, 2024, the complainant filed his Motion for Execution;

Hence, this writ of execution.

NOW THEREFORE, you are commanded to collect, in accordance with Section 9, Rule XI of the 2011 NLRC Rules of Procedure, as amended, the total amount of **EIGHT MILLION TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY SIX THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED NINETY NINE & 88/100 PESOS (P8,276,799.88)** from respondent **Met Express Air Corporation**, located at Block 10, Lot 23, Brgy. Pampang, Hanintown Sub., Cuayan, Angeles City, Pampanga, or anywhere in the Philippines where it may be located, representing complainant's judgment award pursuant to the Decision dated May 31, 2024.

Further collect from the respondent the execution fee in the amount of P82,260.00 and deposit fee of P41,403.99 pursuant to the Manual on Execution.

In case you fail to collect the amounts above-mentioned from the respondents, or the amount collected is insufficient to satisfy the judgment award, you are hereby ordered to cause the satisfaction of the judgment award in accordance with the order of enforcement stated in Section 9 (a), Rule XI of the 2011 NLRC Rules of Procedure, as amended, to wit: (a) Cash bond; (b) Bank deposits; (c) Surety Bond; (d) Personal property of respondent not exempt from execution; and (e) Real Property of respondents.

If the bonding company refuses to comply with the writ of execution, you may proceed to levy on the personal property, and if insufficient, the real property of the bonding company, without prejudice to contempt proceedings against its officers or authorized representatives.
