GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, on October 27, 2021, the Office of the Labor Arbiter rendered a *Decision* in the above-entitled case, the dispositive portion of which reads:

"WHEREFORE, premises considered, judgment is hereby rendered finding the complainant JOLITO N. DAROS to have been ILLEGALLY DISMISSED from his employment by the respondent company.

Accordingly, respondent LEMON GRASS CATERING SERVICES/LEMON GRASS FOOD SERVICES INC. and respondent RAY ANTHONY C. CLEOFE are jointly and severally liable to pay the complainant the following:

- (1) *Full backwages covering the period from September 12, 2020 up to the date of finality of this Decision, which is provisionally computed at Php188,487.00 as of date hereof;*
- (2) *Separation pay equivalent to one (1) month salary for every year of service covering the period from September 15, 2000 to September 12, 2020 in the amount of Php279,40.00;*
- (3) *Service incentive leave pay covering the period from September 15, 2000 to September 12, 2020 in the amount of Php53,700.00; and*

(4) Thirteenth (13th) Month pay covering the period from September 12, 2017 to September 12, 2020 in the amount of Php41,886.00; plus attorney's fees equivalent to ten percent (10%) of the complainant's total monetary award to be remitted to the National Treasury to form part of the special trust fund created for the Public Attorney's Office under Republic Act No. 9406.

The complaints of ERWIN B. ANDALES, CELEDONIO O. ANDALES, and JOVANIE V. MONTALBAN are DISMISSED for failure to prosecute. The complaint against individual respondent GIRLIE C. CLEOFE is DISMISSED. All other claims are DISMISSED for lack of merit.

SO ORDERED."

WHEREAS, no appeal was interposed by any of the parties rendering the above-stated *Decision* final and executory;

WHEREAS, on January 4, 2022, the complainant, through counsel, filed a *Motion for Issuance of the Writ of Execution*;

WHEREAS, on February 16, 2022, an *Order* was issued granting the complainant's aforesaid motion;

WHEREAS, since there is no restraining order or preliminary mandatory injunction issued by any Court or Tribunal enjoining the execution of this case, the execution proceeding shall proceed as a matter of course.

NOW, THEREFORE, you are hereby commanded to collect, in accordance with Section 9, Rule XI of the 2011 NLRC Rules of Procedure, as amended, the amount of **SIX HUNDRED NINETEEN THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY PESOS & 30/100 (Php619,820.30)** from respondents **LEMON GRASS CATERING SERVICES/LEMON GRASS FOOD SERVICES INC.** and **RAY ANTHONY C. CLEOFE** at #19 Carmel Avenue, Carmel Subd., Project 6, Quezon City or anywhere in the Philippines where he/she/it may be located, representing complainant's judgment award pursuant to the *Decision* promulgated on October 27, 2021.

Further collect from the respondent the execution fee in the amount of **Php5,698.20** and deposit fee of **Php3,099.10** pursuant to the Manual on Execution.

In case you fail to collect the amounts above-mentioned from the respondent/s, or the amount collected, is insufficient to satisfy the judgment
